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The Dianne J. Ortynsky Scholarship

Dianne was born in Canora, Saskatchewan in 1947. She attended the Canora Public and Composite High Schools and was a graduate of the U of A College of Nursing. Dianne was an exceptional nurse whose kind and compassionate manner touched the lives of many patients and colleagues throughout her nursing career. Especially important to her was her Ukrainian heritage and her Ukrainian Orthodox faith. Dianne had a passion for life and approached every day with a positive outlook and faced all challenges head on. People remember Dianne for her sense of humour, honesty and integrity. She left a legacy of love and courage. The world is a better place because of her caring and generosity.

To honour this legacy, her family and friends wished to acknowledge her memory by the establishment of a scholarship with a purpose and focus that was very dear to Dianne's heart. In 2003, Dianne's family and the Ukrainian Museum of Canada announced the establishment of a scholarship fund made possible through donations by her family and friends. This scholarship is administered by the Ukrainian Museum of Canada, Saskatoon.

The purpose of this scholarship is to promote Ukrainian culture and heritage by encouraging further educational pursuits and development in the arts. The scholarship is presented to deserving applicants from Western Canada attending a post secondary institution who exemplifies Dianne's ideals. The award is announced at the Annual Meeting of the Ukrainian Museum of Canada. Group projects deemed meritorious by the selection committee will also be considered.

Open to: Individuals/Groups who are pursuing or undertaking a Ukrainian or Educational Activity

Award Amount: \$500.00

Number of Awards: One, to be given annually

Deadline for Application: August 1 of each year

- Conditions:**
1. Individual must be of Ukrainian ancestry
 2. Individual/Group undertaking a Ukrainian cultural or Educational activity deemed by the selection committee to be meritorious.
 3. In support of the submission (individual or group), a minimum of two letters of recommendation verifying the education and/or cultural components are required.
 4. Applicant(s) will supply an outline of academic programming and/or project item.
